# Welcome to THE VETO CAMPAIGN

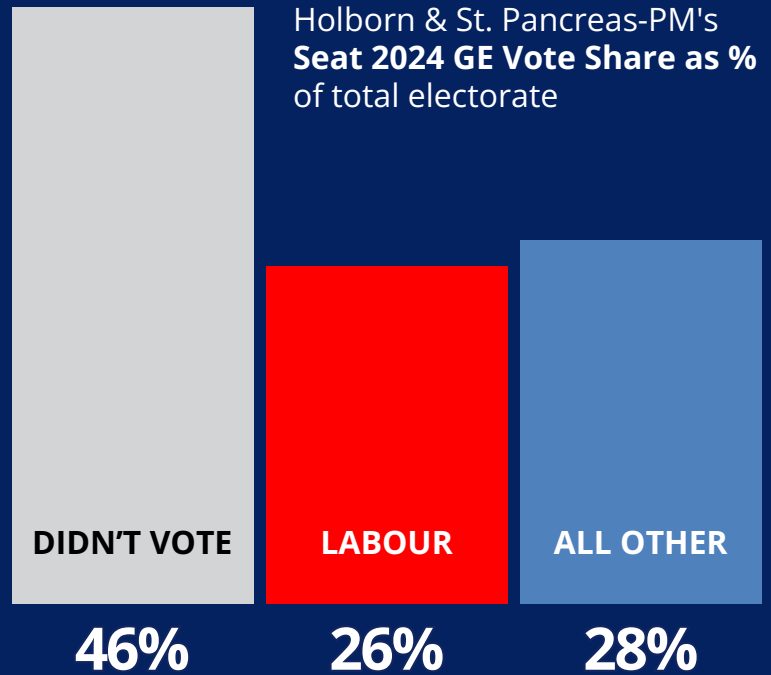


If we caught someone spending our money and borrowing more without our consent, they would face jail time.

Yet, this is precisely how our elections work! There is no evidence that most of our MPs are elected with the consent of the majority. It's a travesty of democracy.

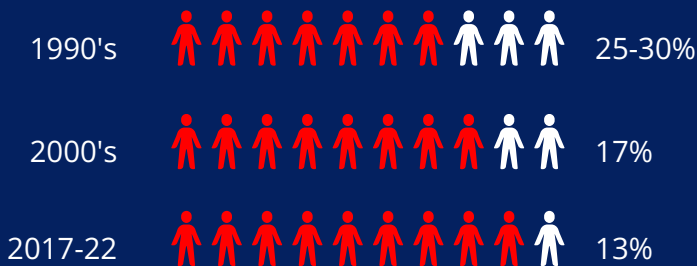
Keir Starmer's electorate is a safe Labour seat, and he could not even receive a majority of votes despite a 54% turnout!

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## WHAT'S THE SOLUTION?

This because PR fills 100% of seats without ensuring everyone who wants to vote is represented. You need a veto where the percentage who choose to veto result in the same percentage of empty seats. Without a veto option, elections cannot be democratic. It's not something that is nice to have, its fundamental. We are being short changed without it.

We can unite around implementing the will of the majority while respecting the freedom of the individual. It's better than allowing political parties to divide us and lie to us.
